

Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2007

EXEMPTION

AIRCRAFT EQUIPMENT and RADIO EQUIPMENT

1. Air Safety Support International, being designated by the Governor under Article 153 of the Air Navigation Order 2007 ('the Order), in exercise of the Governor's powers under Article 146 of the Order hereby exempts the **Falkland Islands Government Air Service** from complying with Articles 15 and 16 of the Order insofar as those Articles require the operator to fit in such aircraft the equipment specified in Schedule 4 and Schedule 5 of the Order, subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The aircraft is operated in accordance with the requirements contained in Overseas Territories Aviation Requirements:

Part 91; or
Parts 119 and 135;

as appropriate to the type of operation in which the operator engages as specified in those Parts.
 - b) Where required under the Order, unless otherwise exempted, the operator holds a valid approval appropriate to the type of operation in which the operator engages as specified in those Parts of the Overseas Territories Aviation Requirements referred to in condition a).
2. This exemption is valid **until 31 July 2010** unless previously suspended or revoked.
