

Competencies for Regulatory Staff

Competency: **Ageing Aircraft Systems**

Description: The ability to assess an organisation’s capability re their management of initial; continued airworthiness and training aspects of ageing aircraft systems.

Note: Elements are in italics.

<p><i>Understanding</i></p> <p>Understanding of what is meant by ageing aircraft systems and the implications for industry and the regulator in respect of initial, continued airworthiness and training of industry.</p> <p>Understanding the safety risks and hazards associated with aircraft systems and equipment and the options required to mitigate these risks.</p> <p><i>Guidance</i></p> <p>Is able to provide expertise in Ageing Aircraft Systems for the development of OTARs and adherence to ICAO requirements.</p> <p>Can provide a focal point for advice to other technical areas on issues involved with ageing aircraft.</p>
<p><i>Persons to whom this is likely to apply:</i></p> <p>Those involved in airworthiness oversight.</p>
