

## Regulatory Competencies

### Additional Technical

### Knowledge/Skills Competency: **Dangerous Goods Regulation**

**Description:** The knowledge to be able to identify dangerous goods and the processes involved in their safe transportation.

*Note: Elements are in italics.*

*Knowledge (K), Skills (S), Behaviour (B)*

#### *Understanding*

Is fully conversant with ICAO Annex 18 and the Technical Instructions, the AN(OT)O and Schedule 10, and the OTARs. (K)

Understands what constitutes dangerous goods and the ways in which they should be packed, marked and shipped and accompanied by suitable documentation. (K)

Understands who is involved in the transportation of Dangerous Goods and the responsibilities involved, including the responsibilities for the handling of dangerous goods emergencies. (K)

Is able to establish which dangerous goods are shipped and audit the appropriate organisations to ensure that procedures and documentation are compliant with requirements, interface correctly between organisations and provide for safe transportation of dangerous goods. (S)

#### *Guidance*

Is able to provide expertise in Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods to support the development of OTARs and adherence to ICAO requirements. (K)

Can provide a focal point for advice to other technical areas on the issues involved in transportation of Dangerous Goods. (K)

#### *Persons to whom this is likely to apply:*

All those responsible for Dangerous Goods regulation
